After an hour of in-door flying, President Randy Doss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at St Mary's School gym. There were 13 members present.

Larry read the minutes from the February 8, 2025 meeting. Dennis read the Treasurer's report. Both reports were approved as given.

Old Business

Larry gave an update on the EAA "Build & Fly" project. The Old School Model Works Fifty Six kit is nearly complete. The local chapter is looking forward to its first flight at our field. They have expressed appreciation to the several SIRS members who have donated time to assist in the build, and who have made this portion of the project possible.

Randy gave an update on the Australian F3A RC competition team that will be practicing at our field in August. He was given assurance that the Australian team's activities will not impact our ability to fly during this period of time, but some accommodation will be necessary.

Larry mentioned that it is time to consider field maintenance, suggesting crabgrass preventer w/ fertilizer, grub control, weed-n-feed, rolling and possible aerating at appropriate times. A motion was made and approved to move forward with appropriate measures.

The EAA Build & Fly Program

The local chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA), Chapter 129, plans to host an Aviation Youth Camp this coming June--the Build & Fly Program. Among the activities planned for the week-long camp will be the building and then the flying of an RC airplane. The EAA has requested the help of SIRS to instruct EAA members this February and March in the building of an electrified Old School Model Works Fifty-Six balsa kit in the EAA hanger at the airport. Many older SIRS members will recognize the kit as an updated version of a Carl Goldberg Falcon 56. The completed plane will be used as a visual prop for the camp. If all goes according to plan, the EAA will build a second kit with the kids in June.

As we all know, there are many similarities between RC models and full-size planes, i.e., structural components, aerodynamics and fundamentals of flight. As part of the curriculum, the students will have access to a Realflight Evolution RC flight simulator, as well as simulators for full-size planes. The EAA has requested, and has been offered, SIRS instructors for the flights at our field.

This program is a great opportunity for SIRS to step forward to gain some visibility in the community, and to give something back. Several SIRS members have already contributed time and talent to the project. Others are encouraged to stop out at the EAA hanger on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 5:00

to 7:00 pm and check things out.
